DOT requires "every hazmat employee" to be trained and tested every three years in hazardous materials procedures and security awareness (HMR 172.704(c)). This includes **any person who transports/handles, loads or unloads any quantity of HM in or from any size vehicle** (warehouse, labs, drivers, management, and admin). Even chemicals designed to be used in our normal lives and households, (such as aerosols) can be regulated and trigger this training.

This seminar is designed to provide the required general awareness, function specific, emergency response, and security training, necessary to satisfy this mandate. Several practical exercises will be sprinkled in and a short test at the end of class will be included. Coaching on the test errors can be an effective learning tool and will be provided. It is being designed to help those that may have to teach the class to your employees.

Check your records for your last training date and find all those who have been hired lately. **Several changes have just recently become effective.** Carriers have received **fines in excess of \$15,000** recently, for a dispatching error. It is highly recommended that our Carriers **bring your favorite shippers** to this important class.
