Lobbying

- Help defeat an oil assessment fee proposal which would have added at least 7 cents per gallon to the state fuel tax.
- Assisted in defeating proposed changes to the joint and several liability laws which would have significantly increased the price of insurance.
- Worked with other business groups to defeat “clean air” legislation that would have significantly increased the price of fuel and utility costs.
- Passed legislation that voids contractual provisions that indemnify shippers for their own negligent, thereby reducing the cost of claims.
- Helped pass legislation that will prohibit the Legislature from diverting transportation user fees for non-transportation programs. (Over \$1.3 billion have been diverted over the last eight years.)

Wisconsin’s Road Team

- Members of the Wisconsin Road Team presented “Sharing the Road” tips to over 12,000 driver education students in 156 schools in 2010.
- The Road Team also attended numerous other events promoting highway safety, highlighting the importance of the trucking industry and discussing careers in the industry.

Safety Programs

- The association recognized over 1,000 truck drivers at 68 companies for their excellent safety records through the WMCA President’s Safe Driver Program in 2010.
- The WMCA Safety Council holds monthly meetings, hosted the annual Safety Banquet, and sponsors the Wisconsin Truck Driving Championships.

College Scholarships

- The WMCA Foundation provides scholarships to three technical colleges for students in diesel mechanics and truck driver training.
